#### TRANSITIONAL STRATEGIC MEETINGS

The St. Andrew's Council and Spirit North Regional Council are clear that alternative futures need to be considered by congregational members. Both Council and the Spirit North believe it is important for the congregation to be involved in determining a future for St. Andrew's United Church,

On Tuesday, January 21<sup>st</sup>, the Council met, along with the Spirit North Regional Council representative to determine the need for a transition process for St. Andrew's. As a result of this meeting and with handouts provided by the Council teams that were prepared for discussion in this meeting, the Council decided to implement a transition process to engage all members of the congregation. This process will take place during the first three Sundays in February. On each Sunday, members of the congregation are invited to take part in conversations about possible alternate futures for St. Andrew's.

Additional information on the financial status of the church will be available at each meeting. Further, as the Sunday meetings occur, additional information will be provided by congregational members.

St. Andrew's Council and Spirit North Region have said that it is immensely important for the congregational members to be present for these meetings.

These will take place in the St. James Room after Sunday Services on February 2nd, 9th, and 16th, 2025.
